Dear Board Development Committee:

As a registered Girl Scout volunteer I am applying to be a delegate to the National Council Meeting in Indianapolis from October 30<sup>th</sup> through November 2<sup>nd</sup> of this year.

A brief summary of my service to Girl Scouts for the past 15 years includes being a leader of troops from Daisy through Senior for my daughters as well as a leader for a Brownie Troop from 2005 - 2007. My purpose in being a leader for this Brownie Troop was multi-fold: 1.) to provide a troop when no other adult volunteered; 2.) through leading this troop to learn how and if girls and their parents have changed over time (since my girls were in a troop) and 3.) to use my experience within this troop to help the leaders of my service unit and to incorporate my findings into Brownie Leadership trainings.

Besides being a troop leader, I am and have been the Service Unit Director for TriCo Service Unit, a Trainer for Council - Brownie Leadership, Team Building, Science, Training of Trainers and other trainings as assigned, and I am a GSUSA Certified Instructor of Trainers. Girl Scout recognitions I have received include Outstanding Leader, Honor Pin and the Wilma Watkins Outstanding Trainer award.

Outside of Girl Scouts, I currently hold two jobs – one as Executive Director of the Greater Fostoria Community Foundation and one as a licensed REALTOR. Other involvement in the community includes past president of Habitat for Humanity, Sunday School Coordinator for Hope Lutheran Church, past chair of the St. Wendelin School Advisory Committee, active board member of the St. Wendelin School Advisory Committee, St. Wendelin Recruitment and Retention volunteer and general volunteer within the school, and Ambassador for the local Chamber of Commerce.

The National Council Meeting will give me an opportunity to represent the Girl Scouts of my area and to enhance my knowledge of the Girl Scout organization as it moves forward. To the convention I will bring my diverse background in Girl Scouts as well as my commitment to the organization.
