Directions:

To Drury Inn & Suites North, 6616 Miller Lane, Dayton, OH 45414

Take I-75 to Exit 59 – Wyse Road toward Benchwood Road. Go east onto Benchwood and then right onto Miller Lane. The hotel will be on your right.

To Girl Scout Office from Drury Inn & Suites North

Go south on Miller Lane toward York Plaza Lane and then left onto Benchwood Road. Take I-75 South to the next exit, Needmore Road (Exit 58). Turn right onto Needmore and follow Needmore about 2 miles when it becomes Shoup Mill Road. The office will be on the left after you cross over the river and go through the intersection of Riverside Drive – it will be the next driveway on the left.
