CALL TO ORDER	The meeting was called to order by Chair, Jody Wainscott, at 4:31 p.m.
<b>APPROVAL OF</b> <b>AGENDA</b> MOTION	A motion was made to approve the agenda. Motion approved.
CAMP GREENE LETTER OF INTENT	Roni Luckenbill, CEO, reported that the Glen Helen Association is preparing to submit the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund grant application and needs board approval in the form of the letter of intent to move forward with the grant request. It is recommended that the board approve the letter of intent since it is non- binding and not a sales contract, but confirms our intent to work towards a mutually agreeable sales terms. Discussion followed. A motion was made as follows:
MOTION	That the board approves the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund Letter of Intent for the sale of Camp Greene dated January 9, 2014.
	Motion approved.
CAMP GREENE SALE PRICE	Roni and Susan Osborn, Chief Strategy Officer, provided an update on recent conversations regarding the appraisal of Camp Greene and the Glen Helen Association's suggested sale price. They reported that the appraised value of \$490,000 is probably too high mostly due to the stipulation that this property must remain a youth camp or it will revert back to the family that owned it and would require us to incur legal fees if we tried to develop the property or sell it for something other than a youth camp, and an EPA report received this week identified a lack of sufficient water source for development. Roni further indicated that the suggested sale price of \$386,000 was too low. It is recommended that the board provide a bottom line sales price and allow negotiations for the best rate above that level. Discussion followed. A motion was made as follows:
MOTION	That the board authorizes Roni Luckenbill, CEO, to accept a sale price for Camp Greene at a minimum of \$390,000.
